Australian National Lighthouse Museum

For some time, we have been speaking with our Coffs Harbour City Council, local members of Parliament, Federal and State, along with AMSA and Lighthouses of Australia to present a case for the Australian National Lighthouse Museum to be located at the Coffs Harbour Jetty Foreshores.



The planning for the foreshores is now in the hands of the NSW Government's consultants, and we have been speaking with them.

While there is still a long way to go

before any formal decision making takes place, we need every member of the Coffs Coast community to support us by writing and making your support known to Council, MPs and Chambers of Commerce.

This is a wonderful opportunity to have this lighthouse museum located in Coffs Harbour, as the Council now has officially taken possession of the former First Order Chance Brothers Lens from South Solitary, and two other significant lighthouse lenses form AMSA. Two more are on offer which would make Coffs Harbour the only place in Australia and one of very few in the world that would be able to display all five orders (sizes) of Lighthouse lens.

We need to keep the discussion on going and reminding those that make the decisions that



this is a chance that other places will take up should we fail to commit to it being located at Coffs Harbour. We are part of the wider community of lighthouse friends and groups across the world. There are three lighthouse lenses currently in storage at the Coffs Harbour City Council facility, including the heritage listed first order Chance Brothers lens, from South Solitary Island Lighthouse,

estimated value at around \$5million.
